As discussed and agreed at our meeting on the Maryville AMP excessing package, I have amended the sites where we have authorized withholding by deleting all of the post offices and plants in the Western area. I am leaving on sites in the Sacramento, San Francisco, Bay Valley and Sierra Coastal Districts for the time being. If we are able to sufficiently reduce the impacts through voluntary attrition, I will adjust the radius and the list of sites further.

Attached is a copy of the planned dates for the equipment and transportation moves. An updated list of withheld assignments will be provided later this week. Complement numbers for the leave behind staffing for the Marysville Post Office will be forwarded once they are received. We will not fill Electronic Technician vacancies by going to the Promotion Eligibility Register. Residuals from the PAR process will be withheld for the placement of impacted employees. Additionally, we cannot guarantee to reserve withheld assignments in the Sacramento District for impacted Marysville employees. However, we will try to minimize dislocation and inconvenience to the extent we can consistent with good business practice.

Sacramento management is plans to issue 60 day notification on April 15, 2010. They met with the Local union on April 5, 2010.
