Subject: San Diego District Maintenance Impacts

This is to advise you of the intent of the San Diego District to utilize the provisions of Article 12.5.C.5 of the National Agreement to involuntarily reassign one (1) Full-Time Regular BEM-9 and one (1) Full-Time Regular MM-7 from the Riverside PO bid installation based on updated Workload Analysis and Summaries. The specifics as to the number of employees to be excessed by occupational code and level are listed below:

The impacted employees will be advised of their involuntary reassignments by separate letter. The final placement date would not normally occur before November 24, 2010; however, it may be necessary to effect the placement process earlier than that date due to the loss of workload and financial condition of the Postal Service nationally. It may also be necessary to utilize the provisions of Article 7.2.B to detail the impacted Laborer Custodians during the notice period in order to provide them with a work opportunity

By copy of this notice the Pacific Area will begin withholding up to two (2) full-time residual assignments in the Maintenance, Clerk, Carrier, and Mail Handler crafts in plants and post offices within a 250 mile radius of the impacted offices. A list of the offices within this radius in which withholding is authorized for the impacted sites is attached.

Copies of the Automated Impact Statements and operational data supporting excessing are attached. Also attached are seniority lists identifying the junior impacted employees for each of the identified occupational codes listed above.

We are placing this impact on the agenda for our next meeting scheduled for June 1, 2010.
