Dear Mr. Gonzalez,

This is to inform you of the U.S. Postal Service's decision to consolidate mail processing operations at the Yakima, WA, Customer Service Mail Processing Center with those of the Pasco, WA, Processing and Distribution Facility.

We advised you on April 29 of our intent to conduct a feasibility study. After review, we have decided this consolidation is in the best interest of the U.S. Postal Service and will result in significant savings.

Because of the drastic decline in mail volume, the Postal Service is in a fiscal crisis and must take action to reduce the size of its mail processing network. Consolidating operations such as this is necessary if the Postal Service is to remain viable to provide mail service to the nation.

We expect this transition to be completed by July, 2012. As part of this consolidation, we may have to reassign some career employees to other vacant positions, in accordance with applicable collective bargaining agreements.
