This letter is an informational notice that the U.S. Postal Service's Area Mail Processing (AMP) study of mail processing at the Juneau, Alaska Customer Service Mail Processing Center (CSMPC) has ended.

On April 29, the Postal Service began an AMP feasibility study to determine if efficiency could be increased by consolidating mail processing operations performed at the Juneau, Alaska CSMPC with those performed at the Anchorage, Alaska Processing and Distribution Center (P&DC).

After careful review it has been determined that moving the mail processing operations to the Anchorage, Alaska P&DC is not in the best interest of the Postal Service. Therefore, the study to move mail processing operations from the Juneau, Alaska CSMPC to the Anchorage, Alaska P&DC has ended.
